NEW ADDITION TO CMP MATCH

There is a new venue being tried out on the rifle range during the CMP match on the 4th Sat. mornings. That is, we are running an NRA sanctioned High Power Rifle match good for establishing NRA High Power Rifle Classification (Marksman, Sharpshooter, Expert & Master).

This is a 50 round course of fire (plus sighters), fired in Prone, Sitting & Standing positions with Slow & Rapid Fire stages. You can use a Service Rifle with any sight system - an AR15 would be excellent – or you can use a Match Rifle. This is an excellent opportunity to use your AR15 or other Modern Sporting/Service Rifle and if you are new to this type of rifle system, to learn how to shoot and operate it.

This is a perfect venue for improving your rifle marksmanship skills and coming away with an NRA Classification, something that very few firearm owners have.
