The First 3D Target

Archery Shooting Tournament

Come out and get your inner hunter on. Our 3D Shoots are held from 8:00 am to 10:00 am during summer months – 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm during winter months. A nominal entry fee of \$5.00 for members/\$10 for nonmembers gets you on the range for a morning of fun and competition. The entry fee will go to Apple Valley Gun Club for target maintenance. The course of targets is set up sort of like a golf course. Shooters start at Shooting Station One and shoot two arrows at Target One, followed by Shooting Station Two and Target Two etc. The course of targets is made up of 7 targets. The tournament



is complete after two rounds, which is 28 shots on target. Scoring will follow the IBO plan where hits can score 11, 10, 8, or 5 points for each shot. A miss counts as zero. A shot on a scoring line scores the higher of the two score areas. Once all archers have completed their two shots on a target, all archers will advance to that target score their shots. They will then move on to the next shooting station/target. Shooters compete with bow classes of their choice, that is Long Bow; Recurve; Compound Bow and Crossbow.
