Muzzleloader Shoots: What to Bring

Any safe Muzzleloading Rifle, Pistol, or Cap and Ball pistol may be used. Flintlock rifles must use a patched round ball. Percussion rifles may use any projectile. Any metallic sight is allowed unless otherwise specified.

Military Small Arms (Musket) Any safe, original, or reproduction, military (as issued by the United States, Confederate States, or by a state government) rifle, musket, carbine, or musketoon of .54, .58, or .69 calibers may be used. Minie-type or swaged bullets. Original pattern sights must be used.

FEES: \$5.00 Members \$10.00 Non-Members (Quarterly shoots as determined by the match director).

AVGC has two .32 caliber muzzleloaders available for use by participants at an additional cost of \$5.00 for consumables.

Targets B-17, B-6, B-8 and NRA A-23 targets will be used at distances of 25, 50 and 100 yards
