### **Pledge of Allegiance**

There have been no safety violations reported until today. While remote range monitoring by Diana. On the Pistol Range, 3 shooters were viewed not using safe gun handling skills to include poor muzzle control, guns uncased at the back table, and handling of guns while others were downrange.

The flowchart for Discipline Action was approved by the BOD and will go into the Policies and Procedures for consistency.

It was stressed our number one job is to protect our members. Safety violations need to be written up and turned in.

It was brought up there needs to be a supply of booties for the Indoor Range. CJ will follow up and be sure booties are used before going downrange.

It was brought up the swamp cooler in the Indoor Range needs to be replaced. This could be a safety issue for our Indoor Range users. It will be put on the BOD agenda and the GM agenda to be approved at our next meeting.

CJ, Junior Pistol reported all is going well

Matt, Match Director brought up there have been problems with RSOs not knowing how the matches run. They have been interfering with the matches. It was clarified; PCC can be shot on the Pistol Range at Matches only. It was clarified, during a match scoring is allowed while people are shooting. NO one is to be out in front of a shooter at any time. Taping is allowed during shooting while behind the shooter. Shooting into the berms is allowed at matches. It is not allowed any other time where shooting should be down range only.
