The Close Call Incident Report Process was reviewed based on the Policy and Procedures Manual.

The incident involving a RSO checking gun chambers and magazines a women's event was reviewed. A motion was made for no further action necessary by Gary Menser and seconded by Diana Roederer . Unanimous to approve.

The video Range monitoring procedure was discussed. Currently Tim S., Diana R., Tracey G., Kyle B., and Jason M. have access to the Video system as Remote Range Monitors. No one is to record video to any device other than a flash drive to be done at the Club. The video will be reviewed by the voting members of the Safety Committee and BOD. Remote Range Monitoring is to be used for the protection and safety of the membership.

An Incident flow chart was discussed and recommendations made. The chart was modified based on recommendations. It was suggested the chart be added to the Policies and Procedures Manual. Violators will be notified by email, mail (certified if needed) and text.
