OLD BUSINESS -

1. Jennifer Tornero: Last call for Banquet Volunteers. The Banquet is Saturday. You don't need a ticket to volunteer. Sign up at the information table or email Jennifer. Also, there are 2 tickets left on Eventbrite.
2. Jennifer Tornero: Call for Volunteers for the Women's Expo. Sign up at the information table.
3. Dina McKinney: Last call for Gun Show volunteers. Feb 29/Mar 1. We need people for the Sunday slot.

4. Diana Roederer: We could not find the prior approval for the new chairs in the Adobe so we are re-submitting a new proposal. Request for Funds NTE \$1,600 for new chairs for the Adobe, which will include Scotch Guard and shipping. Gary made the motion. Tim seconded. No discussion. All in favor. None opposed. Motion passes.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Dina McKinney-Membership vote on the Bylaws. Gary made the Motion to approve the January revisions to the Bylaws. Bill seconded. No discussion. All in favor. None opposed. Motion passes.
2. Tim N.-Training Trap Classroom purchase (carried over from BOD Meeting)- Tim requested a motion to purchase 3 lateral filing cabinets, 1 for the trap classroom, and 2 for the soon-to-be Adobe classroom. Funds NTE \$1,200. Jason made the motion. Rick Smith seconded. All in favor. None opposed. Motion passes.
3. Tim Smith-Sewer line for pistol restrooms: He is working on bids to run the sewer line to the pistol range. There should be a vote at the next meeting! He is looking at a building with two restrooms, including a handicap restroom, and storage area for pistol range.
4. Tim Smith-moving dirt and dressing the berms at the pistol range: This will keep them from deteriorating. Also, by moving the mound of dirt into the big hole this will expand the parking lot.
5. Diana Roederer: Re-cap of safety for the previous month (good and bad): There were problems again with guns being uncased behind the shooting bench at the pistol range. Please remember when you go to the pistol range, bring a cased gun to the shooting bench, make sure muzzle pointed downrange before opening the case. At no time are guns to be uncased at the back table.
Another problem she has seen is people laying guns on shooting benches with the action closed. Remember: mag out, action open, ejection port up.
Exemplary safe gun handling skills award to Bruce Bloomster. Bruce gets a challenge coin. Thank you, Bruce, for staying safe on the range!
6. Introduction of new members. Motion to accept the new members by Tina. Seconded by CJ. All in favor. None opposed. Motion passes. Diana gave probationary requirements.
7. 50/50 raffle with half the proceeds going to the Scholarship Fund- winner Lauren!
