Approval of January 2021 GM Minutes. Motion to approve the minutes as written by Tina. Seconded by Tracey. All were in favor. Motion passes.

Reports

Treasurer- Jonathan Weldy

1. Report on account balances to include Business Checking, Capital Account, Money Market Account, and Scholarship Account.

Secretary- Dina McKinney

1. Membership numbers- 1348 total (667 regular, 516 senior, 162 associate, 3 honorary life), these numbers are fluid as Dina is working through renewals.
2. Advise members of Action Without Meeting that was approved by the BOD-funds NTE \$700 for a roll up door on the pistol shack.
3. If you paid your renewal on time, your membership card has been mailed out so look for it in the mail. CALL/TEXT if not received by the last week of Feb. Renewals paid after Feb 1 will now begin to be processed.
4. 1st annual In-Person Renewal day was a success! We will do this again next year.

Vice President-Tracey Graham

1. Report on Safety at the Range (both good and bad): There was 1 incident that was identified via the cameras. The individual was handling a firearm while their partner was downrange. There were various other safety violations that were addressed with this person as well. There will be a safety hearing on the matter. Overall, folks have been doing well.

- Rifle Range-Jason Myskow: There are new dueling trees at 200 yards that were donated by some members. Everything else is going pretty well. Reminder that we do not allow pistols anymore unless they are hunting style pistols. Also, no shotguns, except for slugs.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Dina McKinney: Hillside College Conference- "Study U.S. Constitution & Practice Shooting Sports" brought before the BOD for consideration by Jonathan. Registration fee is \$325 plus travel arrangements. Do we want to provide a scholarship or 2 or 3 for qualified student athletes from our club? Open for discussion. Discussion held. Motion by Gary to fund 3 AVGC scholarships for this program. Seconded by Bill Stephens. All in favor. Motion passes. Dina advised if you have an interested athlete to reach out and she will give the Brochure.
2. Tim Smith Request for Funds:
 - NTE \$1,600 for fixing the driveway up to the adobe. He has proposal for phase 1 of the project, breaking up the rock and getting it packed down. He does not have a proposal for phase 2 for paving. So, this is just for phase 1. Motion to approve funds NTE \$1,600 by Gary. Dave seconded the motion. No discussion. All in favor. Motion passes.
 - ~\$1,400 to finish the retaining walls on the pistol range for material only. Also, a deal to exchange labor for equipment. Motion to approve funds NTE \$2,000.00 by Gary. Seconded by Dave. No discussion. All in favor. Motion passes.

3. Introduction of new members by Diana. Motion to approve the members by Dave. Seconded by Cecil. All in favor. Motion passes. Tracey went over the probationary requirements.
4. 50/50 raffle with half the proceeds going to the Scholarship Fund. Winner Titika!
