**Approval of August 2021 GM Minutes-** Motion to approve the minutes as written by Tim Neubauer. Second by Jonathan Weldy. All BOD in favor. Motion passes.

### Reports

President-Tracey Graham

1. Advised the membership that the BOD filled the vacant Director seat for the remainder of the term with Jody Patterson. Tracey introduced Jody to the membership.
2. Announced that the 2022 BOD nominations will commence at the October meeting.
3. Announced insulation is being installed in the Pistol Shack. A Split system is being installed and will provide heating and cooling. Tracey thanked Tim Smith and Don McAffe for their efforts in making this improvement.

- Pistol Range-Diana Roederer: Everything is good on the Pistol Range. No issues. Tracey already reported the improvements.
- SASP-Tim Neubauer: SASP has been on break and will be starting again on 9/18/2021 Saturdays at 5:30 PM. SASP will be open to Middle School and High School age students.
- Indoor Range -Kyle Butts/Ray Jameson: The Indoor Range is being used. You can shoot in comfort.  
Kyle made a plea for volunteers for the upcoming events: The Victorville Gun Show, Women's Expo, and The Sheriff's Rodeo. Kyle said without enough volunteers, we will be forced to cancel these events.  
Tracey encouraged members to volunteer. He stated volunteers have been falling off in all areas. We do not have enough volunteers for Women On Target this Saturday. He reminded the membership this is what we do for community involvement.
- Rifle Range-Jason Myskow: Reminded members if you take a target up to the 300 yard line, Please do not leave it there! The swamp coolers are working.
- Trap Range- Gary Menser: We are still in need of a Trap Range Chair. Gary also made a plea for volunteers for our Women On Target event. He let the members know we need RSOs, Coaches and bodies to help with chaperoning etc.

Gary introduced Ryan Hauser of Boy Scout Troop 574 to present his Eagle Scout Project:
