Range Reports

- <u>Pistol Range-Jennifer Tornero</u>: Everything is going well. Thank you, Tim and Don, for getting the insulation in the shack! Everyone is doing great with putting the bases away. Check out the matches!
- <u>SASP-Tim Neubauer</u>: 3rd season just started. Thank you to the volunteers that come to the program. If you want to help, come out! There were some SASP kids that took the Basic Pistol class and a couple of them qualified at instructor level! Way to go kids!
- <u>Indoor Range Ray Jameson:</u> He is working on new lighting for the trench. The range is warm in the winter so come shoot! There has been no shooting of the walls lately, thank you! Jr. Pistol should be starting in January. For Jr. Rifle, Ray is offering a free instructor class for those willing to help.

<u>CRSO Report</u>- If you shoot at the Indoor Range, don't go past the red line for any reason. If anything goes past the red line, just leave it. Remember to bring your guns to the range in cases and only uncase once at the bench. RSO vests-Tim got the decals and they have been sewn on. If you need a new vest or different size, let him know. If you see a safety violation on the range, you need to address it. If anyone gets hostile, report it, and let the Safety Committee deal with it. Attitude is everything!

- <u>Archery Range-John Burke</u>: John went over Open Archery details. Spring will bring the Vegas Shoot, which is a ton of fun so come participate.
- <u>Facilities Tim Smith</u>: This Sunday is Orientation. We have an Eagle Scout working at the Trap Range and we need people to help him out. Work is on-going at the gates with the concrete.
