ELIGIBILITY. Applications are open to rising high school sophomores rough seniors with all levels of firearms experience. While applications are noouraged by April 1, they'll be reviewed until the program has reached capacity, with spots being filled as program fees are received.

HOW TO APPLY. A program application is available online. In addition to e application form, we'll ask you to write a short essay, and to submit two letters ommendation, an official high school transcript, official ACT/CLT/SAT/PLAN/ CLT10/PSAT scores (one required), and a résumé. Once we receive and review your completed application file, a letter and accompanying e-mail will generally be sent within three weeks regarding acceptance, beginning December 1.

AFTER APPLYING. If you're admitted, additional program details will be coming your way, and you'll be asked to submit a non-refundable \$325 program fee to secure your place (limited space will be filled on a first-to-pay basis), as well as a current photo. The fee covers transfers from Detroit Airport (if necessary), three daily meals while on campus, residence hall lodging, course instruction, course materials, and course activities.

Shooting equipment will be provided; the use of personal firearms will require the prior authorization of Range Master Bart Spieth, bspieth@hillsdale.edu.

fillsdale College's John Anthony Halter Shooting Sports Education Center is ocated five miles from the main campus. The 113-acre facility features seven American trap fields, a five-stand sporting clays field, a small arms range, a American trap fields, a five-stand sporting clays field, a small arms range, a skeet field for both American and International skeet, an Olympic bunker, an outdoor Olympic archery range, a 23-station sporting clays course, and a lodge and education center. It will be designated as the Certified Eastern Regional Training and Competition Center for the USA Shooting national team upon completion of four new Olympic combination bunker and trap fields. Future plans also include the construction of an indoor shooting sports facility, which will be outfitted with a SO-meter rifle and pistol range and a 25-meter combination archaru and Olympic relifica and air cited anone. combination archery and Olympic air rifle and air pistol range

The Halter Center supports a celebrated, six-time national championship Division III shotgun team for Hillsdale students, as well as a shooting sports club and an archery club for students interested in recreation or non-varsity competition. One-credit Sport Studies courses offered at the range for Hillsdale students include Introduction to Shooting Sports, Basic Shotgun, Introduction to Archery, Basic Rifle and Pistol, and Intermediate Shotgun.

The Apple Valley Gun Club Membership has approved 3 SCHOLARSHIPS to this program! You must apply through Hillsdale as outlined above and present your acceptance to the Board of Directors for review. Don't miss this amazing opportunity! This will look FANTASTIC on a college application and resume!

The FBI conducted more than 4.3 million gun background checks in January 2021 – the highest number of checks completed during a single month in the agency's recorded history.

Gun background checks are indicative of sales trends, and as we all have seen, it has been increasingly difficult to find certain firearms for sale, short of finding a private party seller and being charged an exorbitant price!

According to an article published on February 2, 2021, by Fox News, "It can't be discounted that many of these background checks for the purchase of a firearm are attributed to threats by the Biden administration to enact the most radical and far-reaching gun control agenda ever proposed," said Mark Oliva, director of public affairs for the National Shooting Sports Foundation, in an email to Fox News. "Americans are continuing to purchase firearms at a blistering pace." Oliva said the month's NICS statistics "clearly spell out that the demand of law-abiding Americans to purchase firearms isn't abating. It is growing."
