Reports

President-Tracey Graham

1. Ryan Hauser, Eagle Scout recognition. Way to go Ryan! Ryan did his Eagle Scout Project on the Trap Range and it looks great!

Vice President-Jenaraye Graham

1. Report on Safety at the Range (both good and bad): Two hearings will be addressed in the Safety Committee meeting coming up. Tracey explained what the purpose of the Safety Committee is to anyone that does not know.

Treasurer- Jonathan Weldy

1. Report on account balances to include Business Checking, Capital Account, Money Market Account, and Scholarship Account. BOD reviewed the ledgers. No questions presented.

1. Membership numbers-Total membership stands at 1,248. (609 regular members, 488 senior members, 148 associate members, 3 honorary life members)
2. Read Action Without Meeting into the Minutes- Motion passed unanimously to move the December meeting to the Fairgrounds.

4. Advised the membership that renewal packets are going out in about a week. Members should get them by the end of December or early

January depending on snail mail. If you don't have them by Mid-January call me!

-In-person renewal day is January 29th from 8-3 with a 1 hour lunch break at noon. You can come renew in person and get your card that same day.

-New Members: If you joined in Oct/Nov/Dec of 2021 you WILL receive a packet and you DO need to complete the forms and return them. You DO NOT need to pay dues; just write on there you joined Oct/Nov/Dec and you will receive your 2022 card once your paperwork is returned.

Range Reports

- Pistol Range-Jennifer Tornero (absent): Jason reported on her behalf. Please move your bases off to the side. If you move bases from one bay to another, please move it back. Bay 3 doesn't have lights right now. If you need hours, you can come to a match and help out.
- SASP-Tim Neubauer: Tim explained the program for the new members. Some of the kids have shot at Instructor level! There was a Christmas party and they decorated clays and shot them.
- Indoor Range -Kyle Butts: There are heaters in the indoor range so it's nice to come out and shoot, especially in the winter! It's .22 only. You need an orientation to get the special code.
Ray- Junior programs are starting back up in January and we need volunteers to help! We need all different positions. Talk to Ray if you are interested.
- Rifle Range-Jason Myskow: Everything is going great, except there is one new hole in the ceiling, so watch where you are pointing your guns!! Please put your target stands away.

No open shooting is on the calendar right now, but there are usually people there all the time. You need to do a special orientation to shoot alone on the trap range. Gary went over pricing.
