Close Call/Incident reports:

- Tim made a motion to move us into a closed session. Seconded by Dina. All in Favor. Motion passes. Two hearings were held in closed session.

Range Reports:

- Facilities-Tim Smith: At the last meeting, Jason said if you take targets from one range, put them back. Apparently members misunderstood, now all the targets are being placed on one range. The wind has been terrible, causing trash cans to go missing and port-a-potties tipped over. Tracey asked for the status of the heater on Pistol. Tim is hoping to get it done next week.
- CRSO-Gary Menser: A member blew up a gun.
- Pistol Range-Jennifer Tornero: Everything is ok. Sam specifically wanted her to ask for more volunteers to help at the matches. There was a discussion held that the people that shoot need to get there early to help set up and tear down. Sam needs additional help with the paperwork involved. Tim stated that Bay 3 power was out. The GFI tripped and it's fine now. The timer knobs were stolen but Tim replaced them.
- Trap Range-Allen Rutledge: no report
- Rifle Range-Jason Myskow: Biggest issue is that the amber lights for going down range sometimes don't work. There might be something wrong with the switch. Sometimes the buzzers don't work either. Tracey said we need to get an electrician to come out and re-wire the building so we stop fighting it. With the influx of money coming from renewals, we need to be looking at that because it's a safety issue. Gary made a motion that the Safety Committee recommend to the BOD that we rewire from the Indoor Range all the way to Big Bore Range. Second by Sandy. Jason clarified an electrician to look at the amber lights, new bells, new lights, new switches, new wires. Vote called. All in favor. Dina will add this to the agenda for January.

- Indoor Range-Ray Jameson: No report. Gary said he is there every Monday, and the range looks great. He did encounter a member shooting who was going to go down range and clean up his brass. Gary needed to explain that you do not go down range in there.
- Archery Range-Sandy Oberlies: She went to sign in for an Archery event and everything except archery was on the electronic event sign in. Tim N. explained the bugs are being worked out.

New Business:

- Deborah Harris reviewed the Range Safety Regulations. She noted her issues with the current regulations as written and went over them with the Committee. Discussions were held. Dina will give Deb a digital copy of the Range Regulations so she can redline it and present her changes as a proposal to the Committee at the January Safety Committee meeting.
