## President-Timothy Neubauer

#### Vice President-Deborah Harris:

1. Report on Safety at the Range (both good and bad): Debbie explained the situation with the gate locking itself open. Reminder, if you show up and the gate is locked open, get a hold of someone on the leadership team.

## Treasurer- Jonathan Weldy:

- 1. Report on account balances to include Business Checking, Capital Account, Money Market Account, and Scholarship Account. BOD reviewed the ledgers and presented no questions.
- 2. Early payments for membership renewals and punch cards- there currently is no prohibition on paying early. We will probably take a look at this policy this year. Early money is for future expenditures that could be a future deficit if not handled appropriately. So, we need to take a look at this policy and reserve for future expenditure. Regarding the match cards that were purchased ahead, this could create the same sort of problem. We will need to manage trends.
- 3. CCW qualifications and additional training- CCW is currently parked and this is a significant impact to our yearly budget. Hopefully this problem is solved in the next quarter.

4. Banking update- Jonathan explained what the finance committee is doing according to the information that he has presented to the membership at recent meetings.

- 1. Report on Membership numbers- total 1,219 (565 regular, 507 senior, 144 associate, 3 honorary life)

## **Range Reports**

 <u>Pistol Range-John Melton</u>: The stands are still getting shot up. Please move the stands to the side so they don't get ruined. There was some steel added to Bay 1

**Dan Floyd - SASP:** There are currently 23 shooters and 6 active coaches. The kids are going to shoot at Mojave Steel Saturday morning. The National SASP director said we are authorized to shoot a state match. He wants to send a team to Nationals to compete in July. Dan went over the details of going to Nationals. They received a donation from Walkers for ear pro. He is selling raffle tickets to help with the program. Dan is a certified Hunters Ed instructor and is working on getting a class back at the club. Dan is also signing up people for the NRA tonight. **Jr Pistol-Don Martin:** Last session there were 15 kids! We need more coaches to help with these programs. We also need more RSOs. There is a request for ammo coming up tonight that we are asking for approval of.

- Indoor Range -Ray Jameson: He needs help with the Jr. Rifle program. Indoor range is only .22 rimfire. No Magnum loads or centerfire whatsoever. People are defeating the lock on the indoor range door, please don't do that. There is a scheduled orientation that follows the work party at 3:00 to get access to the indoor range.
- **Rifle Range-Jason Myskow:** Everything is going pretty well. There are a couple of new steel targets out there. There are also hit indicators now too. Don't shoot magnum or steel core at the dueling tree. Turn the strobe lights off when you leave.

**Alex Montenegro-CMP:** Alex commended the club for the resurgence of the youth programs. He explained the CMP program and the recent shooting matches. March 30th is the military police service pistol match.

- <u>Trap Range- Dave Scheppmann:</u> 5 Star Jr Trap is coming up on Saturday! Come out and see these kids shoot, they are incredible. There will be no open trap on Saturday. Dave went over pricing, dates, and times.
