- Pistol Range-John Melton: Mostly good. Please remember to put target stands back when done shooting
- Dan Floyd - SASP: Tim Kitchens reporting: Had kids shooting some fun targets like the Texas Star and Pop-ups. Had a great time.
- Debbie Shell - SWAG: Tara Nadreau reporting: Match style training for women only. Two levels of training provided - advanced firearm handling & range commands, and advanced defensive skills. **Must be competent with your firearm to participate.** Sign-up on Eventbrite as participation is limited.
- Indoor Range -Ray Jameson: Dave Smith reporting: Range is available for 24/7 shooting. .22 and air guns only. Range rules training required for passcode. Get with range chairman.

- Dave Smith - Junior Programs: AVGC has great junior shooting programs. Jr. Pistol, Rifle, and Trap to teach basic firearm skills to kids ages 8 - 18. SASP for middle school and highschool kids is a National program that teaches more advanced shooting skills. Junior Rifle meets 1st and 3rd Tuesday evenings, Junior Pistol meets 2nd and 4th Tuesday evenings, Junior Trap meets every Wednesday evening. Additional information is on the AVGC website.
- Rifle Range-Jason Myskow: Remember to return target stands to side of range when done shooting. Gate posts have been re-secured. New steel targets have been added. You have to hunt for them. Bring binoculars. Targets are out as far as 500 yards.
