General Info: Scholarship applications shall be submitted to the Apple Valley Gun Club Scholarship Chairperson. Contact information is listed on the Apple Valley Gun Club website (applevalleygunclub.com)

Apple Valley Gun Club offers \$1,000.00 scholarships to applicants for the fall enrollment in a 4-year college/university, community college or trade school. One must submit an application, an essay (as described above) and possibly attend an interview with the Scholarship committee. A GPA minimum of 2.7 is required to apply.

Applicants must provide proof of enrollment at any of the above educational institutions to the scholarship committee. Upon Scholarship award, a \$1,000.00 check will be issued directly to the student.

If the recipient remains eligible (as outlined above), he/she may re-apply the following year.
